

Erosion & Sedimentation Control Certification Training

Are you in compliance?

The Georgia Erosion and Sedimentation Control Law states that all persons involved in land disturbing activities must be trained and state certified no later than December 31, 2006. It is anticipated that well over 20,000 professionals will need to be certified prior to that date.

Depending upon your level of involvement in the land disturbing process, you may be required to attend the Level 1A or Level 1B course and successfully pass a formal examination.
